- a. Facilities Subcommittee
  - Roof repaired on Friday 2/9 by Gibson Roof. Unfortunately, it is leaking again noticed on 2/14/24 - notified Mark Hollis, Town Engineer and Gibson coming back to repair it
  - Results from the chiller leak test
    - They found circuit #1 was about 25 pounds low on refrigerant. They found it
      was leaking from the chiller barrel. I'm waiting on pricing from our vendor on a
      new chiller barrel and will send a quote to replace it once they get it.
    - MPC replaced valve in upstairs vent bathroom; found emergency exit heater leaking/ need new coil.
    - o Recommend treating the water on the hot water system.
  - Security camera signs have arrived. Waiting for them to be installed.
  - The tree in the front of our library has been trimmed.
  - Called MPC today to ask about our back foyer area and a new coil for the Children's room emergency exit.
