### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

## **Contract Discussions**

Kevin received an email from Verizon for a 5 year contract with \$100,000 up front and 5%. The stipulation is that they would not give 5% until Charter approves 5%.

Charter wants a 10 year contract; they will not even discuss a 5 year contract. We will ask for 5% with \$250,000 up front.

Chairman DiCicco wants a summary put together and presented to the Selectmen. Mr. Desrosiers suggested that Kevin be the spokesperson, which was acceptable to all.

### FCC

The FCC voted 3/2 to keep the cap at 5% of revenue. They will allow the providers to charge towns for the in-kind services that are currently free; i.e. municipal drops, carrying the 3 PEG channels, etc.

### Playback System

Kevin is moving forward with the Castus system. It was the least expensive of the 3 quotes. We will have live streaming and video-on-demand of all 3 channels on our website.
