Free House Numbering Program

Lew Evangelidis's Worcester County Sheriff's Department, in conjunction with the Millbury Senior Center, is offering a **FREE** house numbering program to all town residents. This program will not only help to bring homes into code with the house numbering by-law, but will hopefully allow easier identification by First Responders of the appropriate home in crisis.



These wooden signs are 14" long x 5 1/2" wide, and they are ready with holes for mounting. The back of the sign is painted as well.

The green paint around the numbers, has glass particles in it for reflective purposes. Residents need only to complete a simple form available at the Millbury Senior Center, then return it to the Senior Center and they will send it in. When your sign is delivered at the Millbury Senior Center, they will call you for pick-up.
